Visual Text Analysis - Analytical Response

<u>Directions</u>: You will write **an analytical response** to a Public Service Announcement in which you will explain how the message is conveyed. <u>Identify</u> the techniques used, <u>analyse</u> them and <u>justify</u> your response. Follow the steps below to organize your thoughts and select your evidence for your **500-700-word essay**.

- 1. Use the following questions to reflect on the visual text:
 - ✓ Can you identify the author's message?
 - ✓ What visual techniques can you identify?
 - ✓ Which language devices can you identify?
 - ✓ What effect do the techniques have on the reader?
- 2. Review the text:
 - ✓ Think about how you understand the message.
 - ✓ What important examples will support your response?
- 3. Formulate a clear thesis statement or overall argument:
 - ✓ EXAMPLE: "The complex emotions resulting from a desire for connection is effectively portrayed in the text through its use of contrast, text and colour."
- 4. Create an outline for your essay:
 - ✓ Introduction: 1 paragraph.
 - ✓ Analysis/Body Paragraphs: 3-4 paragraphs. Use the SEE paragraph structure.
 - ✓ Conclusion: 1 paragraph.
- 5. Choose examples to use in your analysis:
 - ✓ Must support your thesis statement
 - ✓ Provide clear examples of what you will analyze
 - ✓ Comment on the visual components (remember the signifier and the signified, denotation and connotation)
 - ✓ Comment on the textual components (slogans, statistics, etc)
 - ✓ Use precise terminology (signs, signifier, signified, denotation, connotation, background/foreground, colour, salience, vectors, gaze – offer & demand, panels, gutter, contrast, symbolism)
 - ✓ Consider the audience, purpose and context
- 6. Format your paper:
 - ✓ Include the MLA Header
 - ✓ Think of an original title
 - ✓ Indent the paragraphs
 - ✓ Double space the document
 - ✓ Write the word count at the end
